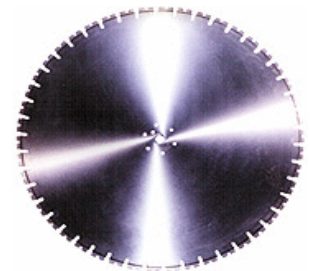
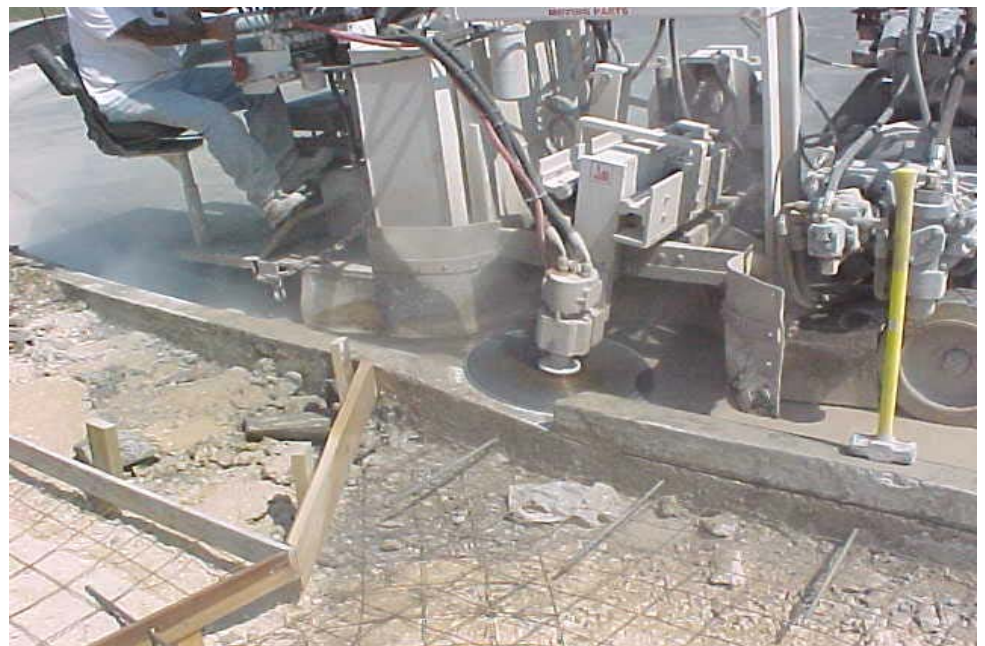

Disadvantages of the "Breakout" Process - (Utilizing a Sledge Hammer):

- At the two front corners where the curb meets the driveway, you have a cold joint. Over time, this is where concrete will typically crack and break. The result is sharp, rough concrete that is hazardous as well as unsightly.
- The extreme front edge of the driveway is typically no more than 1-1/2" thick, leaving it susceptible to breakage and chipping.
- When driveways are poured, concrete often runs under the 2" x 4" that is commonly used to form the front edge. Again, the result is unsightly.
- The breakout process removes the corner of the gutter, allowing water to run under the driveway instead of directing water flow along the curb.
- The impact from the sledge hammer creates stress cracks in the remaining curb.
- Builders often incur warrantee costs due to cracked and broken concrete.



These are the problems associated with creating driveway openings with a sledge hammer.

Benefits of the Georgia Curb Cut Process (Curb-Sawing):

- There are **NO** cold joints. Cracking and breaking, which typically occur at the curb/driveway joint, are eliminated completely.
- Concrete is poured to the back-side of the curb, protecting the front edge of the driveway – no more chipping or cracking of the front edge.
- Ends of the driveway opening are mitered, providing an overall smooth and attractive appearance.
- The curb gutter remains intact, directing water flow where it was intendeddown the street, **NOT** under the driveway.
- Our curb-sawing process works remarkably well with paving-brick or stamped concrete driveway aprons.
